BICS Coaches expectations

Coaches should:

- Set high standards of punctuality, politeness and appearance
- Teach and encourage players to be the best they can be
- Maintain a positive attitude especially in adverse circumstances
- Encourage and nurture in each player the values of self discipline and team work
- Teach players to be a credit to their community, their club and themselves

- Coaches are expected to provide a safe, positive, and challenging soccer experience for all their players.
- Coaches must follow the requirements of the Ontario Soccer Association and BICS Code of Conduct and demonstrate respect for players, parents, and officials.
- Coaches are expected to be familiar with the published rules of the South Region Soccer League and to abide by these rules.
- Coaches are expected to continually learn more about coaching soccer by attending clinics, observing other coaches, and obtaining at least the minimum license qualification required by the OSA.
- Coaches should form a coaching staff that includes:
 - A team manager and
 - Assistant coaches.
- The coaching staff is responsible for their team at all team activities and games.
- Coaches are required to attend all Club meetings, league meetings, and complete all the paperwork necessary to register and compete in both the SRSL and soccer tournaments.
- Coaches are responsible for the financial status of their team. This includes paying for tournaments and collecting any fines incurred by their team's players, parents, or coaches.

I have read the BICS expectations and coaches responsibilities outlined above. I intend to do my best to live up to these expectations in my capacity as a BICS soccer coach, Assistant coach or manager.
